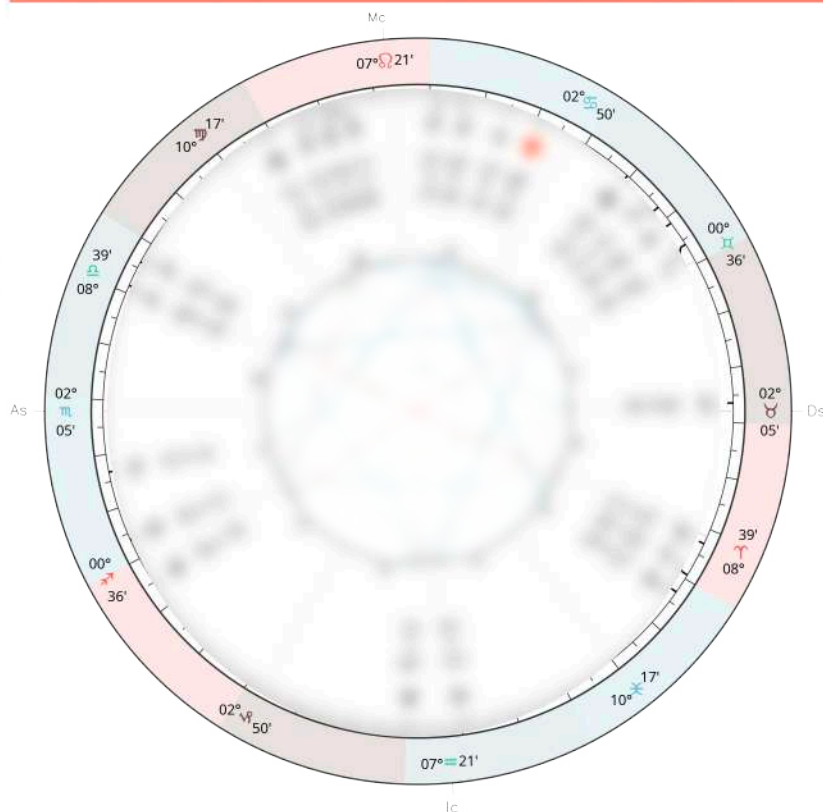

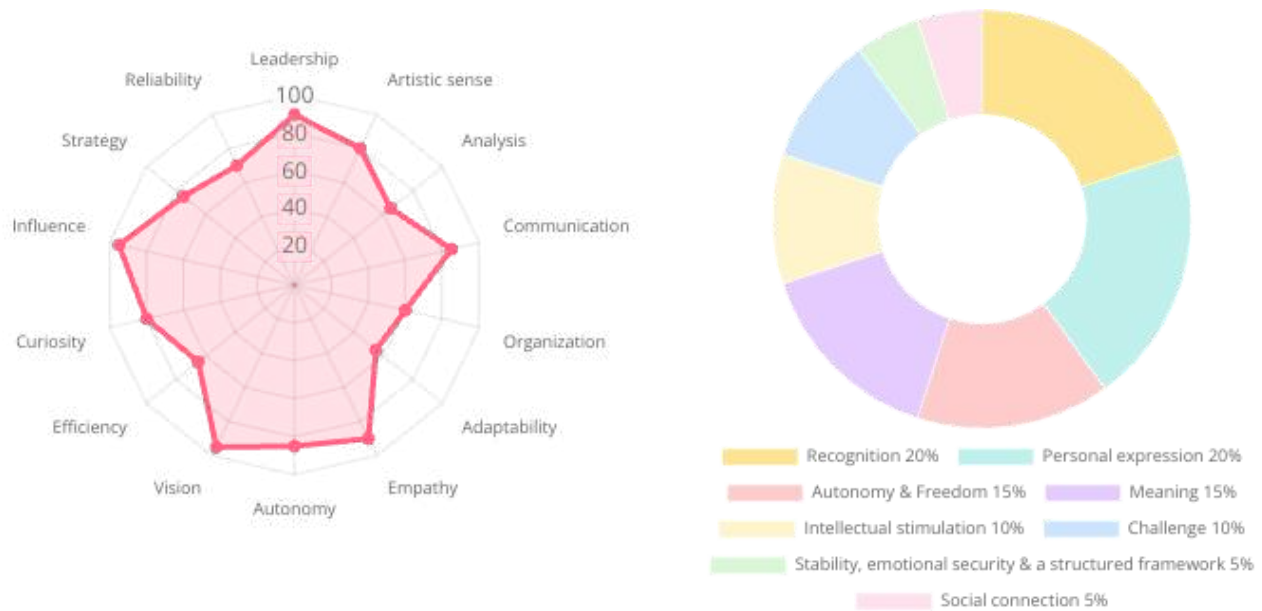

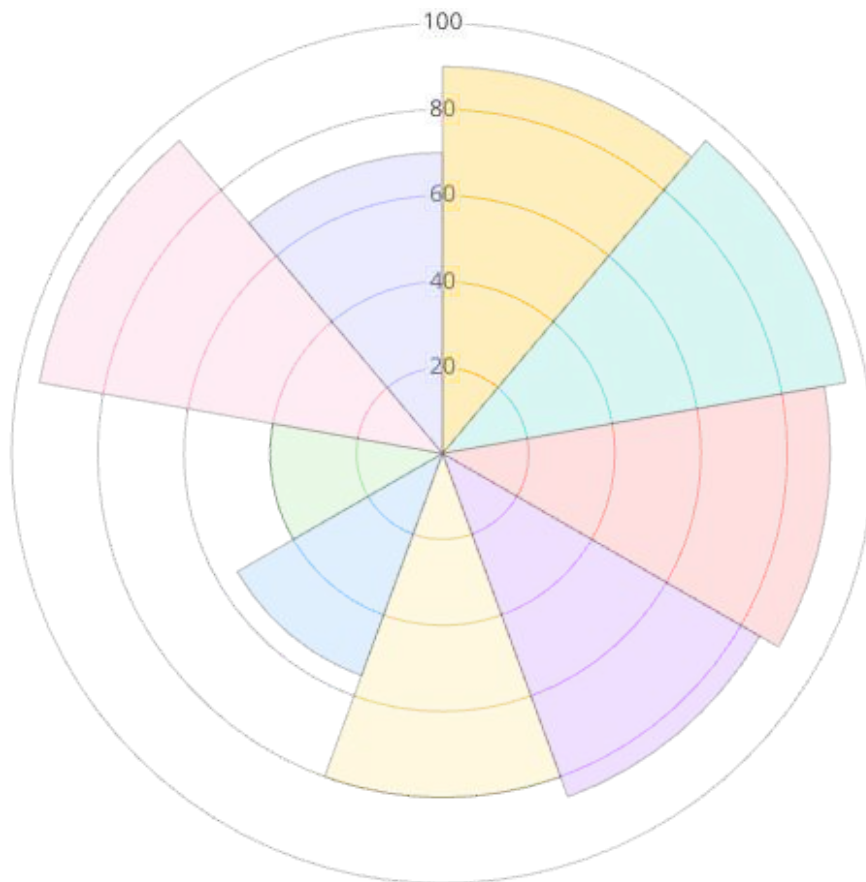

- **Sign associated with House 11:** friendships, group projects, vision of the future, social commitment.
- **Pisces:** A Water sign ruled by Neptune (and Jupiter in traditional astrology), it embodies sensitivity, imagination, empathy, and unity with the whole. It feels deeply, dreams big, and seeks oneness.
- **Sign associated with House 12:** inner world, intuition, spirituality, solitude, unconscious.

» THE PLANETS

- **Sun:** *Identity – Consciousness – Self-expression – Father figure*
Represents the core of personality, deep will, life goals, and what we are called to radiate. It symbolizes how we affirm ourselves in the world.
- **Moon:** *Emotions – Emotional needs – Intuition – Mother figure*
Expresses our inner world, sensitivity, intuition, instinctive reactions, and essential needs for safety.
- **Mercury:** *Communication – Thinking – Logic*
Symbolizes how we think, speak, learn, and share. It is the planet of the mind, analysis, and exchange.
- **Venus:** *Love – Values – Relationships*
Represents our way of loving, attracting, and connecting. It also relates to our tastes, values, and relationship with beauty and pleasure.
- **Mars:** *Action – Desire – Assertion*
Mars represents vital energy, the courage to act, survival instinct, and how we pursue desires and initiatives.
- **Jupiter:** *Expansion – Faith – Growth*
Planet of luck and openness, it symbolizes optimism, confidence, justice, and opportunities for growth.
- **Saturn:** *Responsibility – Structure – Time*
Represents discipline, limits, learning through effort. It calls for maturity, patience, and long-term building.

- **Uranus:** *Freedom – Change – Awakening*

Brings disruption, innovation, and awakening. It urges us to break patterns, be authentic, and follow a unique path.

- **Neptune:** *Dream – Intuition – Illusion*

Planet of the unseen, Neptune relates to spirituality, compassion, inspiration, but also confusion and illusion. It opens imagination and mystery.

- **Pluto:** *Transformation – Power – Regeneration*

Symbolizes deep processes of death and rebirth. It highlights fears, shadow areas, and pushes inner transformation.

» SENSITIVE POINTS AND SYMBOLIC ARCHETYPES

- **Ascendant (House I):** *Gateway – Appearance – Instinctive personality*

Determined by exact birth time, it marks the start of the houses. It is the first energy we radiate, shaping spontaneous behavior and how others first perceive us. It also influences personal style and body awareness.

- **Midheaven (MC or House X):** *Reputation – Career – Vocation*

Represents public role, how we are seen socially, and deep ambitions. It points to life mission and professional fulfillment.

- **Chiron:** *Inner wound – Healing path*

Represents a deep vulnerability often felt early in life that, once integrated, becomes wisdom and guidance for others.

- **Black Moon (Lilith):** *Instinct – Shadow – Repressed desire*

Points to what is hidden, taboo, or magnetic. It also symbolizes raw feminine power or taboo sexuality.

- **North Node:** *Growth – Soul mission – Learning path*

Indicates the direction of evolution in this lifetime. A new, sometimes uncomfortable energy essential for growth and fulfillment.

- **South Node:** *Past – Comfort zone – Acquired skills*

Shows natural talents and familiar patterns. While comfortable, they may hinder growth if overused.

- **Part of Fortune:** *Inner joy – Natural flow – Abundance*

Reveals what brings harmony, joy, and ease, areas of life where doors open naturally.

- **Vertex:** *Fateful encounters – Destiny – Karmic portal*

Considered a "destiny call" point, activated by key encounters or events of deep significance.

» ASTROLOGICAL ASPECTS

- **Conjunction (0°):** Two planets aligned, merging energies – sometimes harmonious, sometimes excessive.

- **Sextile (60°):** A supportive, cooperative connection.
- **Square (90°):** Tension or inner challenge, calling for integration of opposing forces.
- **Trine (120°):** Ease, natural flow, harmony between energies.
- **Opposition (180°):** Polarity or tension, inviting balance and complementarity.
