

- Aries: A Fire sign ruled by Mars, it represents impulse, instinct, the will to act and to start. It carries the energy of beginnings, with vitality directed towards action.
- **Sign associated with House 1:** the image we project, our approach to life, spontaneous behavior, self-assertion.
- **Taurus:** An Earth sign ruled by Venus, it embodies stability, sensory pleasure, loyalty, and construction. It moves forward with patience and seeks emotional, material, and sensory security.
- **Sign associated with House 2:** relationship with money, security, self-worth, and tangible needs.
- **Gemini:** An Air sign ruled by Mercury, it expresses curiosity, the need to learn, move, and connect. It loves to explore, question, converse, and understand the world around it.
- **Sign associated with House 3:** communication, learning, exchanges, relationship with close environment (siblings).
- Cancer: A Water sign ruled by the Moon, it embodies gentleness, sensitivity, the need for protection and belonging. It is linked to memory, home, childhood, and emotional care.
- **Sign associated with House 4:** roots, family, intimacy, inner security, connection to the past.
- **Leo:** A Fire sign ruled by the Sun, it shines through generosity, creativity, confidence, and a need to be recognized. It expresses itself with heart and fully embodies its inner light.
- Sign associated with House 5: self-expression, creativity, love, children, joy of living.

- **Sign associated with House 6:** daily work, sense of service, health, organization, attention to details.

- **Sign associated with House 7:** relationships with others, partnerships, commitment, relational mirror.

Planet of the invisible, Neptune speaks of spirituality, compassion, connection to something greater, but also confusion and illusion. It opens us to imagination and mystery.

• Pluto: Transformation - Power - Regeneration

Pluto symbolizes deep processes of death and rebirth. It highlights fears, shadow zones, and drives us toward inner transformation.

>>> SENSITIVE POINTS AND SYMBOLIC ARCHETYPES

• Ascendant (House I): Gateway - Appearance - Instinctive personality

Determined by the exact birth time, it marks the starting point of the astrological houses. It's the primary energy we radiate. It influences our spontaneous behavior, how we approach new situations, and how others perceive us at first. It also shapes our personal style and body awareness.

• Midheaven (MC or House X): Reputation - Career - Vocation

The Midheaven represents our public role, how we are seen socially, and our deep ambitions. It also points to our life mission or how we fulfill ourselves professionally or collectively.

• Chiron: Inner wound - Healing path

Chiron shows an existential wound often felt early in life, a vulnerability that, once healed, becomes a source of wisdom and guidance for others. It holds deep meaning in spiritual or therapeutic readings.

• Black Moon (Lilith): Instinct - Shadow - Repressed desire

The Black Moon evokes what is hidden, taboo, or fascinating. It points to a void or lack in the chart. It also represents untamed feminine power or taboo sexuality.

• North Node: Growth - Soul mission - Learning path

The North Node indicates the direction of evolution in this life. It's a new, sometimes uncomfortable energy, but crucial for personal growth, fulfillment, and breaking past patterns. It guides us toward our deeper calling and the qualities we must develop.

• South Node: Past - Comfort zone - Acquired skills

The South Node shows natural talents and automatic behaviors, possibly from past lives or childhood. Though familiar, these patterns may hinder growth if overused. It represents what must be released to move toward the North Node.

• Part of Fortune: Inner joy - Natural success - Personal abundance

This symbolic point reveals what brings us simple joy, natural harmony, and "obvious" happiness. It also points to areas where life can open up more easily if we cultivate that quality within.

• Vertex: Fateful encounters - Destiny - Karmic portal

Seen as a "destiny call" point. It is said to be activated during significant, meaningful, and

often unexpected life encounters or events.

>> ASTROLOGICAL ASPECTS

- Conjunction (0°): Two planets side by side: they merge their energies, for better or for excess.
- Sextile (60°): A fluid link, natural cooperation potential between two energies.
- Square (90°): Tension or inner challenge: a need to reconcile two seemingly conflicting forces.
- Trine (120°): Ease, natural gift, smooth harmony between two parts of the self.
- **Opposition (180°):** Pulling in opposite directions, polarity: two parts of the self face each other, inviting balance and complementarity.
